MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is executed on 05.12 2024, by and between:

Gayatri Vidya Parishad College of Engineering for Women(A), an engineering institute duly constituted under the State of Andhra Pradesh having its establishment at Madhurawada, Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh 530048 ("Institution");

AND

MICROCHIP TECHNOLOGY INDIA PVT LTD., a private limited company incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956, having a registered office at No. 149-B, 1st Phase Industrial Area, Whitefield, Bangalore - 560 066 and its corporate affiliates including MICROCHIP TECHNOLOGY INCORPORATED, a Delaware corporation, with a principal address at 2355 West Chandler Boulevard, Chandler, Arizona 85224, and MICROCHIP TECHNOLOGY IRELAND LIMITED, a company organized under the laws of Ireland, with a principal address at Ground Floor, Block W., East Point Business Park, Dublin, Ireland 3 (collectively, "Microchip");

University and Microchip are individually referred to as party and collectively as parties.

WHEREAS:

- (a) Gayatri Vidya Parishad College of Engineering for Women(A), established in 2021, affiliated to Andhra University and approved & accredited by AICTE and NBA,NAAC. The college offers B.Tech courses across various specializations such as Computer Science and Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering, and Information Technology courses, EEE and CSM.
- (b) Microchip is a leading provider of smart, connected, and secure embedded control solutions. Its easy-to-use development tools and comprehensive product portfolio enable customers to create optimal designs, which reduces risk while lowering total system cost and time to market. Microchip's solutions serve a huge variety of customers across industrial, automotive, consumer, aerospace and defense, communications, and computing markets. Microchip Technology India Pvt. Ltd. is a subsidiary of Microchip Technology Inc. headquartered in Chandler, Arizona, Microchip offers outstanding technical support along with dependable delivery and quality.
- (c) The Memorandum of understanding (MOU) is a statement of joint interest of both parties with the objective of fostering collaboration between the two institutions to promote academic collaboration and engagement. University and MICROCHIP wish to enter into a MOU wherein the Parties can explore possibilities of engagement & collaboration through the various engineering, technology & research capabilities offered by University leading to drive integrated problem solving.
- (d) The Parties intend to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within the areas of skill-based education, training, internship, placement, industrial visit, expert lecture, collaborative research projects etc.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MoU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS

1. OBJECTIVES OF THE MOU

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding, is:

- (a) to promote interaction between Institution and Microchip, in mutually beneficial areas.
- (b) Value added engagement from both parties to enhance the knowledge base of employees of Microchip and sharing industry best practices with students & faculties of various disciplines of university.
- (c) to provide a formal basis for initiating interaction between Institution and Microchip.

2. PROPOSED MODES OF POTENTIAL COLLABORATION

2.1 At Microchip's sole and absolute discretion the parties may collaborate through one or more of the following projects or any such other projects as may be mutually agreed in between the Parties:

- (a) Explore opportunities for joint research programmes undertaken by faculty of Institution and Microchip personnel on topics identified by Microchip.
- (b) Visits by Microchip employees to the Institution to review / view research work and laboratories, discussions and delivering lectures on industrial practices and trends, sabbatical, and co-teaching.
- (c) Workshops, conferences, and symposia with joint participation of the faculty of Institution and Microchip.
- (d) Short-term assignment, live projects to faculty members and students in Microchip.
- (e) Training / education of Microchip personnel through education programmes conducted by Institution in areas of interest to Microchip.
- (f) Any other appropriate mode of interaction agreed upon between Institution and Microchip.
- (g) Training / Education including practical exposure of Institution faculty, through Faculty Education Programs conducted by Microchip in areas of interest to the Institution.

3. CONFIDENTIALITY

- (a) The term "Confidential information" shall mean any information disclosed by one party ("Discloser") to the other ("Receiver"), pursuant to this MoU or otherwise, which is in written, graphic, machine readable or other tangible form and is marked as "Confidential" or "Proprietary" or in some other manner to indicate its confidential nature. Confidential information may also include oral information disclosed by one party to the other, pursuant to this MoU, provided that such information is designated as Confidential at the time of disclosure and reduce to a written summary by the disclosing party, within 30 days after its oral disclosure, which is marked in a manner to indicate its confidential nature and delivered to the receiving party.
- (b) For the term of this MoU, each party, shall treat as confidential all confidential information of the other party, shall not use such confidential information except as expressly set forth herein or otherwise authorized in writing, shall implement reasonable procedures to prohibit the disclosure, unauthorized duplication, misuse or removal of the other parties confidential information and shall not disclose such confidential information to any third party except as may be necessary and required in



connection with the rights and obligations of such party under this MoU. Without limiting the foregoing, each of the parties shall use at least the same procedures and degree of care which it uses to prevent the disclosure of its own confidential information of like importance to prevent the disclosure of confidential information disclosed to it by other party under this MoU.

- (c) Confidential information shall not include the information which.
- i. was generally known and available at the time it was disclosed or became generally known and available through no fault of the receiver, was known to the recipient of such information, without restriction, at the time of disclosure as shown by the files of the Receiver in existence at the time of disclosure.
 - ii. is disclosed with the prior written approval of the Discloser.
 - iii. was independently developed by the Receiver without any use of the confidential information, and by employees and other agents of the receiver who have not been exposed to the confidential information, provided that the Receiver can demonstrate such independent development by documented evidence prepared contemporaneously with such independent development.
 - iv. becomes known to the Receiver, without restriction, from a source other than the disclosure without breach of this MoU. by the Receiver and otherwise, not in violation of the Discloser's rights.
 - v. In addition, each party shall be entitled to disclose the other party's confidential information to the extent such disclosure is requested by the order or requirement of a Court, administrative agency, or other governmental body, provided that the party required to make the disclosure shall provide prompt and advance notice thereof, to enable the other party to seek a protective order or otherwise prevent such disclosure.
 - vi. The parties shall, upon expiration of this MoU, promptly deliver to each other all material in its or in its employees' possession or control containing such confidential information.
 - vii. The provisions of this Clause shall survive the expiration or termination of this MOU for a period of seven-year subsequent academic years. However confidential information in the nature of intellectual property rights, trade secrets and/or such confidential information which needs to be protected/kept confidential owing to applicable law(s) shall be kept confidential in perpetuity by the Receiver.

4. Intellectual property

- (a) Microchip shall retain all rights, title, and interest in and to any research project IP generated by using Microchip Confidential Information. employees ("Microchip IP"). Institution shall retain all rights, title, and interest in and to any Research Project IP generated solely by Institution faculty or students ("University Project IP") without the use of any Microchip Confidential Information. Nothing in this MoU grants any authority for any Party to use the name, trademarks, service marks or trade names of the other for any purpose whatsoever, without the prior consent of the other Party.
- (b) Institution hereby assigns to Microchip all intellectual property rights, whether patentable or not, created in whole or in part, by its faculty, employees, agents, students or in collaboration with Microchip as part of this MoU.



- (c) At the expense and upon request of Microchip, Institution and its faculty shall execute all documents evidencing assignment of all patent, trademark, and/or copyright applications and registrations to Microchip, its successors, assignees, or nominees, and shall fully cooperate with Microchip and its attorneys as reasonably required in connection with the preparation of any such applications and registrations and will execute all papers necessary to protect Microchip 's rights therein.

5. NON-EXCLUSIVITY

The relationship of the parties under this MoU shall be nonexclusive and both parties, including their affiliates, subsidiaries, and divisions, are free to pursue other agreements or collaborations of any kind. However, during the Term and for 1 year after expiration or termination of this MoU, the student or faculties of Institution involved in the projects, research etc. with Microchip, shall not be involved in any similar projects, research etc. with or for a competitor of Microchip.

6. Amendment To MoU

No amendment to this MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing jointly by the parties hereto or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment to this MoU.

7. TERM AND TERMINATION

(a) This MoU shall be valid for a period of 3 years and can be terminated by either party with a prior written notice of 3 months served on the other Party.

(b) Despite termination, the parties shall abide by the usual professional ethics and normal code of conduct to maintain the confidentiality of the information and intellectual property rights.

(c) In the event of expiry or termination of this MoU (irrespective of the reason for such termination), the following shall apply:

- (i) Institution shall submit to Microchip all the supporting documents, working papers, research information gathered pursuant to any collaboration under this MoU.

8. RELATIONSHIP

Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be deemed or construed as creating a joint venture or partnership between the Parties. Except as expressly set forth in this Agreement, no Party is by virtue of this Agreement authorized as an agent, a partner, employee or legal representative of the other Party, and the relationship of the parties is, and at all times will continue to be, that of independent parties.



9. ASSIGNMENT

It is understood by the Parties herein this MoU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each party and hence neither Party shall not transfer or assign this Agreement, or rights or obligations arising hereunder, either wholly or in part, to any third party.

(a) FORCE MAJEURE

If either Party is prevented from or delayed in carrying out any of its obligations under this MOU by reason of force majeure, the Party whose performance is so prevented or delayed, upon prompt written notice thereof to the other Party, shall be excused from such performance to the extent and during the period of such prevention or delay.

Force Majeure shall mean any cause which is beyond the control of the Party invoking force majeure, including, but limited to, and whether or not of the same class or kind like: any government authority, riot, war, hostilities, public disturbance, an act of the public enemy, strike, Government orders, pandemic, epidemic, lock-out or other labor disputes, fire, flood, earthquake, storm, explosion, or acts of God.

10. GOVERNING LAW & DISPUTE RESOLUTION:

This MOU and any collaboration under it will be governed by laws of India. The Parties will attempt amicably to resolve any controversy, dispute or difference arising out of this MoU. However, if no such resolution is reached, the Parties consent to submit to arbitration under the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996. The arbitration proceedings will be presided by a sole arbitrator appointed mutually by the Parties and the venue of arbitration shall be Visakhapatnam. The proceedings shall be held in the English language. The award shall be binding on the parties, subject to the applicable laws in force and the award shall be enforceable in any competent court of law. The courts in Visakhapatnam have exclusive jurisdiction to try any matter under this MoU.

11. ANTI-CORRUPTION

Each Party agrees, with respect to any activities undertaken relating to this Agreement, to comply with the provisions of all applicable Laws related to corruption in India viz. the Indian Penal Code, 1860, The Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, The Benami Transactions (Prohibition) Act, 1988 and The Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002 and other relevant laws applicable globally in this regard (the "Legislation"). Each Party agrees to ensure that it and all of its Representatives who are engaged in implementing this MoU are knowledgeable regarding the purpose, provisions and principles of Legislation. Each Party further agrees to take appropriate steps to ensure that it and such Representatives, in the implementation of this MoU, will comply with the Legislation and will not take any action which would cause such Party to be in violation of the Legislation. (d) University agrees to comply with Microchip's Supplier Code of Conduct,



as applicable, posted at Microchip's website (www.microchip.com/about-us/corporate-responsibility/ethics-conduct) incorporated into this MoU by this reference.

12. COSTS OF THE MOU

Each Party shall bear the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this MoU.

13. GENERAL

- a) Both parties will designate a representative from its side who will be the primary point of contact on behalf of that party and the details of such a representative will be part of the respective scope of the project.
- b) Institution while ensuring the implementation of the purpose shall be solely responsible for obtaining all statutory permissions/ licenses/ approvals required, if any, for the said purpose. Microchip shall not be responsible or liable except to the limited extent of contribution for the purpose.
- c) In case any assets are purchased or created out under any projects initiated under this MoU, then Institution shall ensure that such assets are not be alienated, leased, hypothecated, mortgaged or disposed-off in any manner by the any person without the prior written approval of Microchip.
- d) In the event of any loss/damage/expenses etc. occasioned to Microchip, as a result of any lapse/neglect/fault/omission/act by the Institution, breach of any applicable law, breach of any provisions of this MOU, then Microchip shall be entitled to claim from the Institution, the value of said loss/damage/expenses etc.



Whereas the second party, GVPCEW has established all the curriculum related laboratories and has employed very highly qualified faculty to train the students both in theory and practice with the best administrative and academic management. GVPCEW has set best objectives to impart quality and high standard education. Internship and practical training are included in the curriculum as mandatory.

COMMITMENT OF THE FIRST PARTY, CEMS

- A. To train the students of B.Tech. M.Tech. and MCA for various courses as per mutually agreed timings and fees
- B. To permit them to undergo practical training under the supervision of a person in charge.
- C. To permit them to get hands on training in the available equipment.
- D. To train the Faculty of GVPCEW at a 50% discounted rates indicated at (A) above.
- E. To offer certificates to the programs conducted by CEMS.

COMMITMENT OF THE SECOND PARTY, GVPCEW

- A. To permit the students of internship to extend their services to the first party as and when required without any obligations what so ever.
- B. To arrange the transportation for the students, to and fro CEMS.
- C. To permit first party to conduct orientation program.
- D. To adjust the course calendar as feasible so as to permit the students to undergo training on weekdays/weekends for pursuing Certification Courses as well as Diploma courses as each diploma course is a combination of two or more certificate courses.
- E. To permit the technical staff / faculty of the first party to GVPCEW to take the training in theory from the qualified faculty in the areas of expertise of GVPCEW
- F. To take all the initiatives to send only disciplined candidates for taking practical training from the first party.
- G. To permit members of the first party to undertake training in GVPCEW depending on mutual convenience of the two parties.
- H. To popularize facilities of CEMS to the students and to further motivate them for undergoing internships to make them eligible for employment.
- I. To offer expertise of qualified faculty to the first party in the areas of common interest.

It is important for both parties to this agreement to be reasonable in every aspect of activity undertaken by both parties to achieve common goals. Rates specified will be reviewed every year from January onwards.

The purpose of the MOU is strictly limited to the expression of the parties to the mutual understanding and cooperation and is not intended to impose any legal obligations of any nature on either party.


